2023 - 2024 Member Registrations

Registrations for 2023 - 2024 season are now due for all who have swum 4 or more times in the Summer Season.
Registrations are done in SwimCentral.

Our 2023 - 2024 season fees are as follows (excluding processing fees):

12 months - Club Swimmer - \$155
12 months - Full Swimmer - \$170
Single season - Club Swimmer - \$140
Single season - Full Swimmer - \$155
Second claim swimmer - \$70

We as a committee recognise that increases to the cost of living have put a strain on a lot of household budgets so we have kept our membership fees as low as possible. In addition, we offer a 15% discount on the club component of our fees for families who register multiple people in the same transaction.

Below is a breakdown of the membership types & fees:

Club Swimmer - for those who want to swim at our Club hosted events only
Swimming NSW / Swimming Australia - \$79
MetSEA - \$4
Club Component - \$72 (12 months) / \$57 (Single season)

Full Swimmer - for those who want to swim at club AND externally hosted meets
Swimming NSW / Swimming Australia - \$92
MetSEA - \$4
Club Component - \$74 (12 months) / \$59 (Single season)

As a not-for-profit organisation, the club component charged goes back to our club members in the form of relay prizes, social events, presentations, and general expenditure incurred in weekly club operations (e.g. pool hire).
